BEACH PARTY

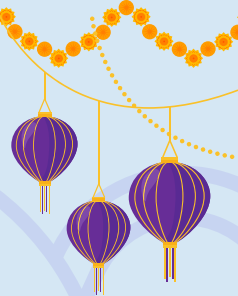
"Come to the beach, where the sea is blue, where the lil' white wave comes running at you!

As Mahatma Gandhi said: "The best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others." True joy lies in the act of giving without the expectation of receiving something in return.



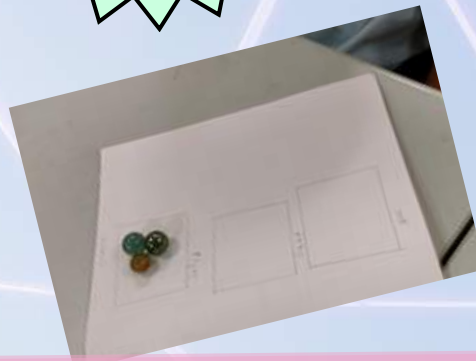

PENTAGON PETAL- ENGLISH ACTIVITY

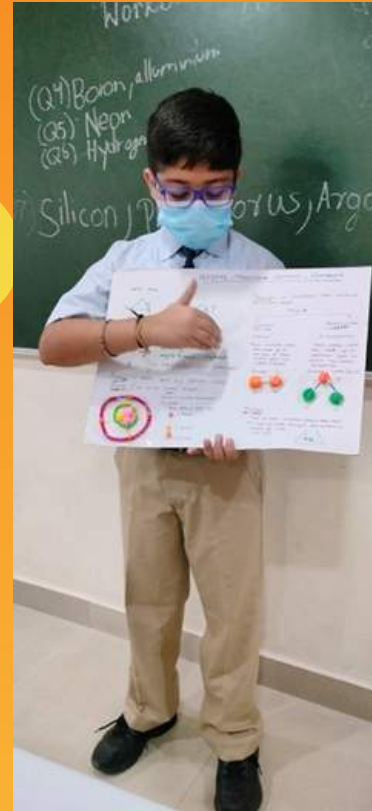
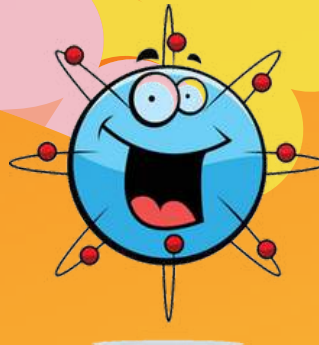
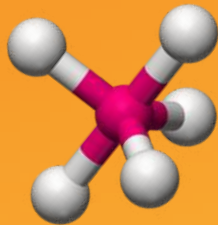
